The scholarship is awarded to an outstanding student entering the English M.A. program who has an excellent undergraduate record, evidence of commitment to graduate studies in English as well as leadership abilities in college and community organizations.

Deadline for Application: March 1, 2017

A \$4000 Russell M. Robinson Scholarship will be awarded to an outstanding student entering the English M.A. program in the Fall of 2017 and is renewable for a second year.

- ▶ A completed application to the English M.A. program

Criteria for Selection

- ▶ Outstanding undergraduate record
- ▶ Evidence of commitment to graduate studies in English
- ▶ Evidence of leadership abilities in college and community organizations
